



Opening of Southwest Healthcare Inland Valley Hospital New Patient Tower and Expansion of Specialized Services in Early 2026

Southwest Healthcare Inland Valley Hospital will open a new patient tower in March 2026. This action is being taken to address the region's growing demand for these services.

The seven floor, 217,444 square foot advanced acute care hospital located at 36485 Inland Valley Drive, Wildomar, CA will increase the hospital's capacity from 120 licensed acute care beds to 202 licensed acute care beds. The new tower will house key clinical programs that will either relocate or expand from their current locations. Inpatient and Outpatient clinical staff will also relocate to the new tower.

Services at the new tower will include: 100 General Acute Care Beds (18 Intensive Care and 82 Unspecified General Acute Care), Basic Emergency Medical Services, Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory Services, Occupational Therapy Services, Outpatient Services – Physical Therapy, Outpatient Services – Radiological Services, Nuclear Medicine Services, Outpatient Services – Surgical Services, Physical Therapy Services, Respiratory Care and Social Services.

The closest comparable facilities, also contracted with Medicare/Medi-Cal, are Rancho Springs Hospital, Loma Linda University Medical Center – Murrieta, Menifee Global Medical Center, and Temecula Valley Hospital.
